

Regular Monthly Meeting
Fort Pierce Farms Water Control District
Board Of Supervisors
February 11, 2026

Present were Supervisors Philip C. 'Flip' Gates, Jr., Robert Johnson, and Dominick Scotto, Attorney Katherine Rossmell, Engineer Patrick Helms, Advisor Steve Cassens, and Secretary Patricia Kuta. Also present was Wade Yarborough.

Upon motion made by Supervisor Gates, seconded by Supervisor Scotto and carried, the January Meeting minutes were approved, as were the expenses for January 13 through February 11 in the amount of \$61,110.28.

Attorney Rossmell reported that the printing company is working on mailing out the referendum to increase the maintenance tax will be mailed out with a return date of March 6, 2026. Work is continuing on the Maintenance Agreement with Buc-ee's.

Mr. Cassens reported that Canals 1, 3, 5, 7, 11, 12, 17, and 18 were sprayed for primrose, peppers, grasses, torpedo grass, Australian Pine, and water lettuce. Canal 2 washouts have been repaired. The rocks throughout the District, primarily Canal 1, have been herbicided. Weed eating/cleanup of the Gates Structure is being done. Coordination with the County regarding the Johnston Road culvert repair continues.

There were no permits recommended for approval.

Projects under review include 4540 Kings Highway (Canal 4), Canal 17 at Johnston Road, Sabal Palm Grove, and Kings Highway (Canals 1 and 4).

With no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
